**Regarding Supplementary examinations for Even Semester of 2020
(for B. Tech., M. Tech., B. Arch. & MCA Programmes)**

Registration for supplementary examination of even semester of both CBCS and NIT scheme shall be carried out from 31.12.2020 to 07.01.2021. **The students, due to appear in same, MUST register on MIS during the declared dates.** Only regular and those ex-students who registered for the DIGITAL EXAMINATIONS of even semesters (SPRING 2020) held in the month of June - August 2020 and were absent/not able to pass shall be eligible to register in these supplementary examinations. No other student will be eligible to register for this supplementary examination. **The schedule of the examinations will be released shortly in the Institute Website.**

Supplementary exams for Even Semester B.Tech, B.Arch, MCA and M.Tech will be conducted as 'Digital Examination', in which the students will be given online (through email, WhatsApp, etc.) open book questions by the concerned subject teachers from the syllabus covered in earlier offline and later online classes, of which lecture notes, presentations, etc., have already been shared to the students. Students will have to write the answers to these questions and send the scanned copies (or images) of the written answers on the email or WhatsApp to the concerned subject teacher within three hours.

Those students who have been declared fail due to shortage of aggregate of marks should make an evaluation of their shortfall (whether the same can be overcome by appearing in digital end semester exam of two subjects comprising of 20 marks each). If not able to make up this shortage of marks, then they may choose not to appear in these examinations. Such students will be given a chance to write paper & pen examination once the Institute reopens for the students.

Please note that the procedure and the mark distribution has been already declared for the End Semester Digital Examination (SPRING 2020) held in June-August 2020. It is being reproduced for ready reference.

- The modified distribution under NIT Scheme (weights of continuous components and end-semester component) for theory subjects of 2nd, 4th, 6th and 8th Semester B.Tech, 2nd, 4th, 6th and 8th Semester B.Arch, 2nd, 4th and 6th Semester M.Tech (Applied Geology), 2nd and 4th semester M.Tech (Engg. Branches) and 2nd, 4th and 6th Semester MCA is approved to be modified as per the Table 1.
