‘Swachhta Pakhwada’ will be celebrated in the institute from 1st September 2016 to 15th September 2016; as per MHRD instructions.

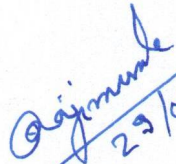
For this purpose, various cleanliness activities and other activities (which will promote cleanliness), will be held in the institute during the afore mentioned period.

3. Essay Competition of students will be held.
4. Painting and slogans Competition on SWACHHTA will be held and the best slogan will be displayed in the institute at various places in the form of Banners.
5. SWACHHTA Awareness message will be placed on institute website.
6. All Kinds of waste materials will be removed from the premises.
7. Audio- Visual programme on SWACHHTA will be displayed in the institute to motivate the students and employees of the institute to maintain cleanliness.
8. The students will go to a nearby place ‘KOTA’ and Saraswati Nagar railway station and will clean the public facilities there, in association with the local people of ‘KOTA’. This will be done by the N.C.C and N.S.S students of the institute.
9. A Committee of Hostel students will be formed (Boys and Girls) which will clean the hostel premises.

10. A competition will be held for the students, in which the students will make an 'Integrated' solid waste management plan for NIT, Raipur.
11. A machine will be procured, which will do the shredding of waste paper, and this waste paper will be sent for recycling.
12. We, at NIT, Raipur; will ensure that there should be no use of 'polythene' in the institute.
13. We will also ensure that all the toilets in the institute and in the hostels are clean.
14. Every faculty member and staff member will maintain cleanliness in his office/workplace and the cleanest office/workplace will be given prize.
15. White washing of the whole institute and residential quarters will be carried out.
16. Proper publicity will be given to PAKHWADA activities in electronic, social media such as Mygov, Twitter and Face book and print media platforms.
