ABOUT RAIPUR:

As per the Imperial Gazetteer of India, 1991 the history of Raipur was found upto 9th century. The city was named after King Brahmadeo Rai of Kalchuri Dynasty. The city of Raipur is located near the centre of a large plain, sometimes referred as the "rice bowl of India". It is the capital of Chhattisgarh. Raipur is the biggest city of the region having a population of 15 lakhs and a fast developing important industrial centre. The city lying on the Mumbai - Nagpur - Howrah mainline is well connected by air/rail and is a good base to visit the tourist centers of the region. It is situated between 22° 33' N to 21°14'N Latitude and 82° 6' to 81°38'E Longitude.

The new state of Chhattisgarh was formed on November 1, 2000. A new capital city "Naya Raipur" is being developed 25 km away from Raipur.

Bhilai-Durg township are only 28/35km from the city.
